Her brother was fixing his bicycle.


"Go away," he said,

"OK," said Zeenah.






Zeenah went to Muna. But Muna was doing her homework.






"Mama I need some help," said Zeenah.







"Salaam alaykum," said Zeenah.




Zeenah said,

"I ate too much. My tummy hurts."




Asmaa's mother came to the door.

"I want to go home now," said Zeenah.


Zeenah went home.
She rested on the sofa.



"It's your favourite. **Popcorn**!" he said.










