# Preface

All praise is for Allah, the One who loves purity and makes it a path to closeness to Him. May peace and blessings be upon our beloved Prophet Muhammad ﷺ, who taught us how to worship Allah with clean hearts, clean words, and clean bodies.

Wudu (ablution) is the beautiful way Allah prepares us for salah. In the Qur'an, Allah commands the believers that when they rise for prayer, they should wash the face and arms, wipe the head, and wash the feet—and He reminds us that He does not intend hardship for us, but rather purification and gratitude. Wudu is not only washing with water; it is a moment to slow down, remember Allah, and begin our prayer with care.

This book has been written to help children—and the families who guide them—learn wudu clearly and correctly. It begins with the importance and rewards of wudu, including teachings of the Prophet ﷺ about purification, forgiveness of sins, and the special blessings connected to making wudu well. Then it guides you step by step through wudu: intention, washing the hands, rinsing the mouth and nose, washing the face and arms, wiping the head and ears, and washing the feet—while also reminding you how many times each action may be done.

You will also find the du'ā after wudu, what breaks wudu, when we must make or renew wudu, and how to handle doubts. Finally, the book explains tayammum (dry ablution) for times when water cannot be used.

May Allah make our children among those who love purity and love salah.

## Wudu' (Ablution)

O you who have believed, when you rise up for prayer, wash your faces and your hands up to the elbows, and wipe your heads, and wash your feet to the ankles.

(Quran 5:6)

Allah does not intend to make difficulty for you, but He intends to purify you and complete His favor upon you so that you may be grateful.

(Quran 5:6)

The basic form of purification for prayer is called Wudu' (ablution)

## Importance of Wudu

The Messenger of Allah (ﷺ) said:

"Purification is half the Iman."

[Sahih Muslim].

The Messenger of Allah (ﷺ) said,

"He who performs the Wudu' perfectly (i.e. according to Sunnah), his sins will depart from his body, even from under his nails."

[Sahih Muslim].

The Messenger of Allah (ﷺ) said,

"When a Muslim, or a believer, washes his face (in the course of Wudu'), every sin which he committed with his eyes, will be washed away from his face with water, or with the last drop of water; when he washes his hands, every sin which is committed by his hands will be effaced from his hands with the water, or with the last drop of water; and when he washes his feet, every sin his feet committed will be washed away with the water, or with the last drop of water; until he finally emerges cleansed of all his sins."

**[Sahih Muslim].**

The Sahaba asked the Prophet (ﷺ),

"O Messenger of Allah! How will you recognize those of your Ummah who are not born yet, (on the Day of Judgement)?"

The Messenger of Allah (ﷺ) said,

"They (my followers) will come with bright faces and white limbs because of Wudu'; and I will arrive at the Haud (Al-Kauthar) ahead of them."

The Messenger of Allah (ﷺ) said,

"The adornment of the believer (in Jannah) will reach the places where the water of Wudu' reaches (his body)."

The Messenger of Allah (ﷺ) said,

"Whoever of you performs Wudu' carefully and then says:

أَشْهَدُ أَنْ لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ وَحْدَهُ لَا شَرِيكَ لَهُ  
وَأَشْهَدُ أَنَّ مُحَمَّدًا عَبْدُهُ وَرَسُولُهُ

'Ash-hadu an la ilaha illallahu Wahdahu la sharika Lahu,  
wa ash-hadu anna Muhammadan 'abduhu wa Rasuluhu

[I testify that there so no true god except Allah Alone, Who has no partners and that Muhammad ((ﷺ)) is His slave and Messenger],  
the eight gates of Jannah are opened for him. He may enter through whichever of these gates he desires (to enter)."
